17. Korean American Family Service Center (KAFSC)	\$10,000	Program Service Grant to partially support the Youth Community Project Team and the Unni-Hyung mentoring program
18. Korean Community Services of Metropolitan New York (KCS)	\$10,000	Program Service Grant to support the only ethnic home delivered meal program for Chinese and Korean home-bound clients
19. Korean Family Counseling & Research Center (KFCC)	\$2,500	Program Service Grant to hire a part-time professional counselor to provide mental health counseling & preventive services
